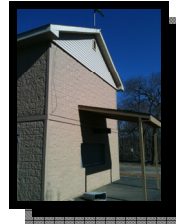
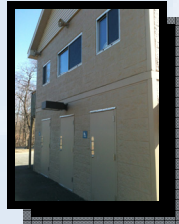

The work also included regrading of the field with the installation of an drainage system and artificial turf playing surface. ADA compliant handicap access was installed to the bleacher areas as well. PCI was responsible for design as well as the preparation of the plans and specifications. During the construction phase, PCI was responsible for inspections, logistics, schedule, and coordination of the work with multiple contractors and utilities. PCI reviewed and approved all of the contractor's payment applications based on actual as-built quantities installed. As well, PCI was responsible for quality assurance testing and project close-out.
