PCI has planned, designed and conducted construction inspection of utility work in the State Right-of Ways as follows: Installation of approximately 8,000 linear feet of 12-inch ductile iron water main on Route 117 in the Town of Mount Kisco. Installation of water main connections at the Intersection of Broadway (Route 9) and Elizabeth Street in the Village of Tarrytown. Installation of water main and repairs of a water main trench on Route 141 in the Town of Mount Pleasant. Installation of approximately 1,800 linear feet 12-inch water main on Bedford Road and Broadway (Route 141) in the Village of Pleasantville. Rehabilitation of miscellaneous Water Main breaks in various municipalities in Westchester County. Sewer rehabilitation work on Route 48, New Jersey.

The work includes inspection services for the installation of water mains, repair of water main trenches, implementation of traffic control plans, restoration of pavement, traffic signal loops, stripings, pavement markings, installation of traffic signs, and sidewalks in accordance with standard State construction specification manuals.
